- 4. Personal data will be processed on the basis of Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR.
- 5. Your personal data may be made available to other entities, including IT service providers and entities authorised under the law.
- 6. Your personal data will be processed:
- in the case of participation in the conference, until the end of the event,
- in the case of issuing certificates or attestations confirming participation in the event, for a period of 3 months.
- 7. You have the right to request access to your data, the right to rectify or restrict its processing, and the right to transfer your data.
- 8. Due to the fact that APoż uses the services of Microsoft Corporation, your data may be transferred to the USA. We have entered into agreements with Microsoft Corporation and other suppliers so-called Standard Contractual Clauses. This means that, in accordance with European Commission Decision No. 2021/914 EU of 4 June 2021, your personal data may be processed by this company in the USA.
